RULES AND POLICIES

- RULE I No practices may be held on match fields
This rule may be set aside in special circumstances, but only by majority vote of the board membership is taken on the issue in either a regular or special board meeting.
- RULE II No alcoholic beverages should be present or consumed at the soccer complex.
This rule should be followed at all practice locations as well.
- RULE III No pets are allowed on the soccer complex grounds.
- RULE IV Use of tobacco products by coaches and volunteers in the presence of youth players is discouraged.
- RULE V Decisions of the referees are final.
Any conflict or discussion should be reserved till the end of match and taken up with the referee coordinator or other such official within the LYSA organization.
- RULE VI Spectators are required to stand at least on yard from the sideline.
- RULE VII No one is allowed in the area behind the goal.
- RULE VIII Players are required to wear safety equipment for practice and games.
Players must wear shin guards for play and practice. Turf shoes with cleats (no 'toe' cleat) are strongly recommended.
- RULE VIV Players are discouraged from wearing jewelry of any kind.
Officials will determine if any item in their opinion poses a safety risk at start of play.
Players may be rejected for play until such risk is eliminated. For conflicts, refer to Rule V.

Climbing on soccer goals and nets is dangerous and is prohibited.
